Goal #2 - Do we know how many people have accessed UtahHealthScape? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HealthInsight sends Google analytics to OHCS as part of deliverable 	
Goal #3 - What about public? How can we reach them? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Media outlets interested in creating public website - this will be ongoing. • We also hope we can connect Maternity Data and UtahHealthScape to those folks, linking there if possible. When an employer has agreement with an insurer, are we as a state committee taking on too much responsibility? Something they can't do this on their own.

Maybe we consider sending out free sample to share something of value to employers and suggest these are the types of things your administrators can be doing</p>	
<p>Goal #4: What Quality measures is Qualified Entity looking at next?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Still discussing, HEDIS specs changed a bit and are looking for pharmacy lookback on diabetes. May ask for a variance on that. Looking at Diabetes care, A1c screening and breast cancer screening. <p>AUCH HIE Pilot Data - they are still working on this, there was some complications with data sent to UHIN, still in progress. Question: Will it still continue?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Feedback is that it takes a lot of time. Lukewarm interest but AUCH does want it to be a priority. Will be conversations about how to offset time and cost associated with it but for now still moving forward. 	
<p>Goal #5 - Dental Data We have been collecting dental data into APCD for about a year. Pulled together initial meeting of dental stakeholders and providers to identify use cases. Will continue to meet and come up with use cases for the data. Question: Any promising use cases that would be good for when data does come in?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Price shopping. Dental care is very shoppable, easy to call around for prices. Well defined commodity and service.
