Diabetes/Neuropathy measure: Those	

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<p>providers that are above 90% might not be as meaningful because standard of care has been addressed more broadly, what can we do on community basis?</p> <p>Still identify outliers and target them. This measure may not be as useful as other potential measures</p>	
<p>Process measures can be hard to understand; it doesn't always mean higher is better. Leaves burden on provider to justify treatment. Average end user won't understand subtlety.</p> <p>NQF 33 is being calculated with other projects using APCD data, the U19 Harvard project, we may see alignment there.</p> <p>Chlamydia-hard to define sexually active and makes this problematic.</p> <p>Need to be clear on what standard practice is and that public understands</p>
